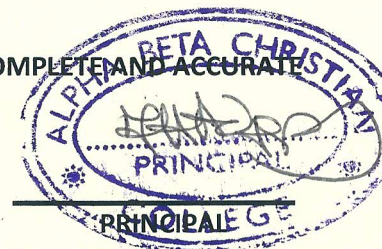

Alpha Beta Christian College for the purpose of ensuring the highest standards of teaching, learning and assessment of our students, in preparation for entry into university degree courses, have opted for a British curriculum and examination board. Please note the following information:

Examination Board: Cambridge International Examinations (**CIE**) organized by Cambridge University, United Kingdom

Examinations offered:

❖ **Advanced Level (A Level)**

These are **two year** courses which lead to the CIE Advanced Level examination in the final year of secondary school (Upper Sixth Form) The Advanced Level is an internationally recognized and highly sought after **entry qualification** into universities and colleges worldwide.

❖ **Advanced Subsidiary Level (AS Level)**

These are **one year** courses which **may** be taken in the Lower Sixth Form and which lead to a CIE examination qualification at AS Level. With **some** courses this can be carried forward to complete the two year Advanced Level examination.

NB. The above courses are taken during the **Sixth Form**, that is, Lower Sixth and Upper Sixth. These are the final two years of secondary school in which students prepare for entry to university.

❖ **International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)**

These are two year courses leading to the CIE **IGCSE** examination taken by students in **Form 5** of secondary school and which prepare them for Advanced Level courses in the Sixth Form.
